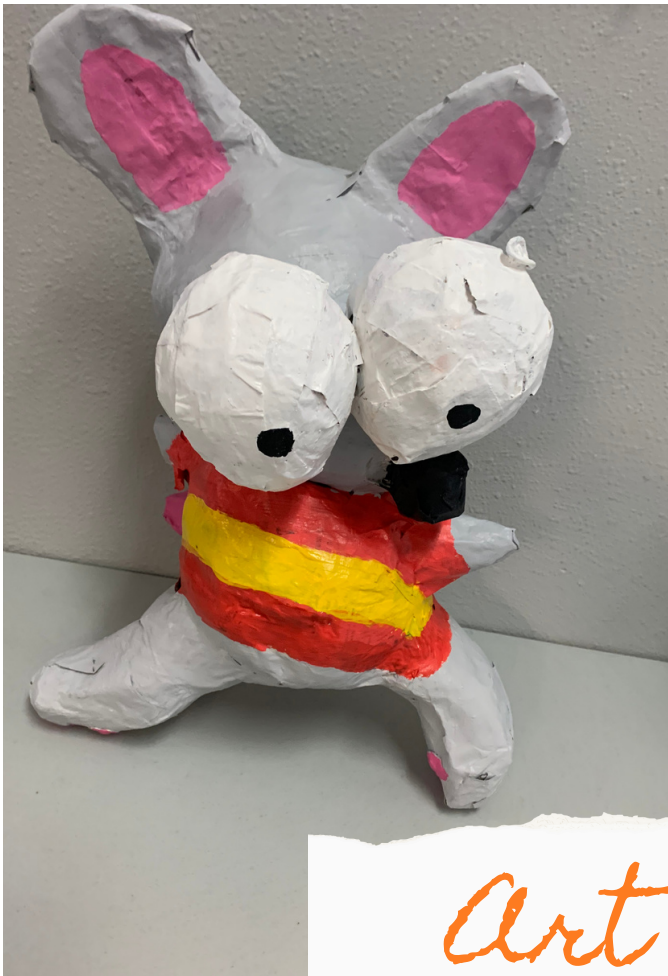

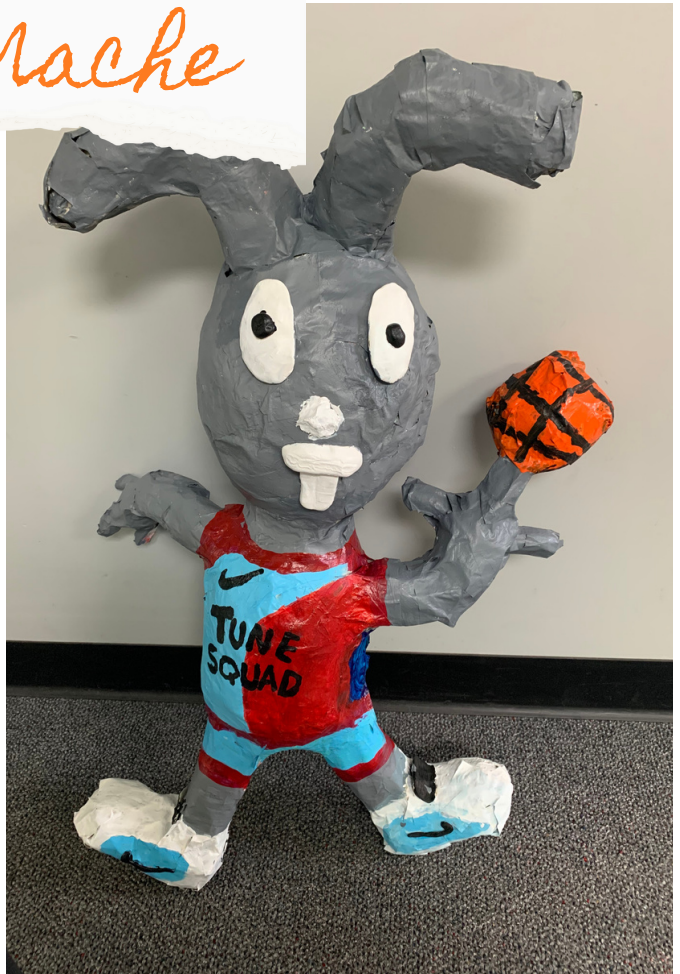
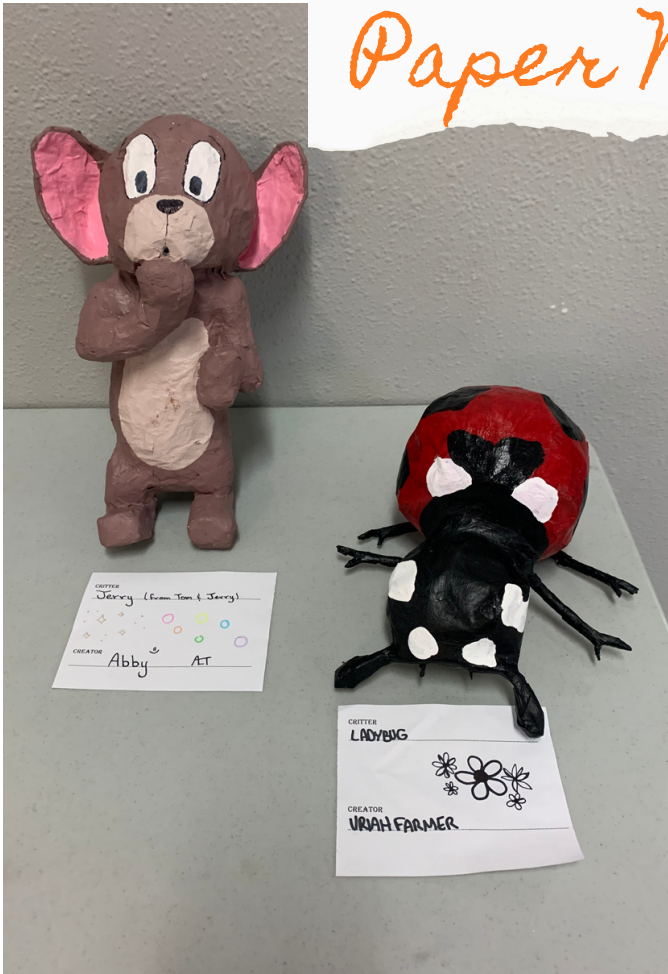
Praise Item

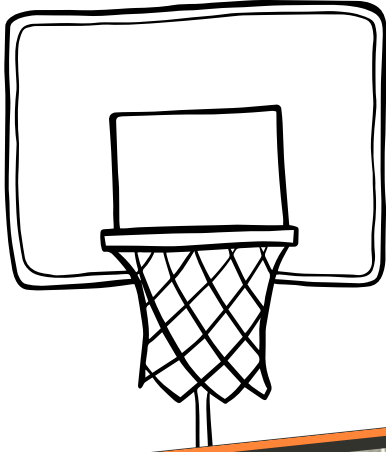
