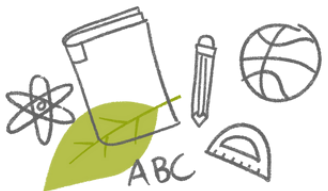
At HCS, we're unlocking the wonders of the universe, one elementary science project at a time!

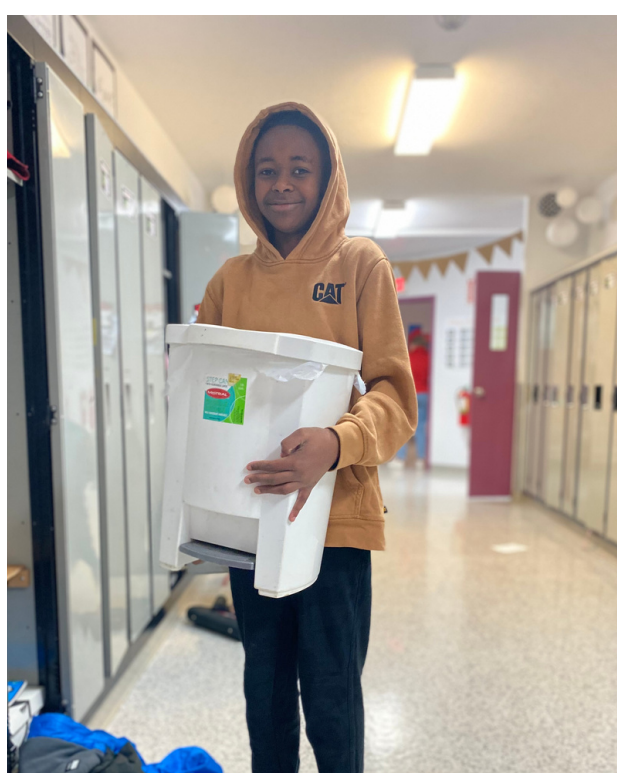
Congratulations to our junior volleyball teams! The girls' team took first place and the boys' team won bronze at their Zones tournaments over the weekend!
