In 1962, Houston Christian School embarked on its journey, welcoming 47 students into the basement of the Christian Reformed Church. Today, as we celebrate our growth to 164 students, we pause to acknowledge the blessings bestowed upon us by our faithful God. Looking forward, we are driven to expand and improve our facilities to meet the needs of our increasing enrollment.

The proposed expansion comes with a price tag of \$815,000, representing a significant investment in our school's future. To finance this endeavour, we anticipate a monthly debt service of around \$6,000, or \$72,000 annually, over 25 years. With \$115,000 in equity on hand, our goal is to minimize the amount to be financed to \$700,000.

The school board is conducting a donation pledge drive throughout February to secure the necessary funds for the project. Two weeks ago, the board sent a letter to the community providing further information about the planned addition. In the letter, the board invited the community to join them at a Special General Meeting on February 29, 2024, at 7:00 pm. During this gathering, they will provide updates on fundraising efforts and hold a crucial vote to determine the project's fate. Your support and participation are crucial as we endeavour to shape a brighter future for Houston Christian School.

In the words of past president Peter Lieuwen, "With the help of parents and supporters, we will continue to steward our school in the years ahead. We trust that the Lord will bless us as He has in the past. The strength of our Christian community lies in our faith and humility, always turning to the Lord for guidance."
