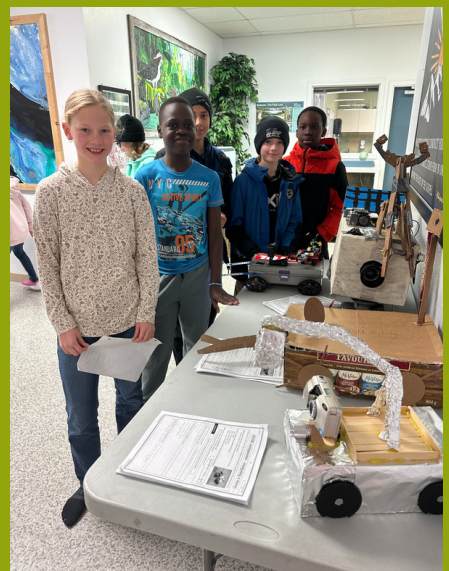

Building a Rover

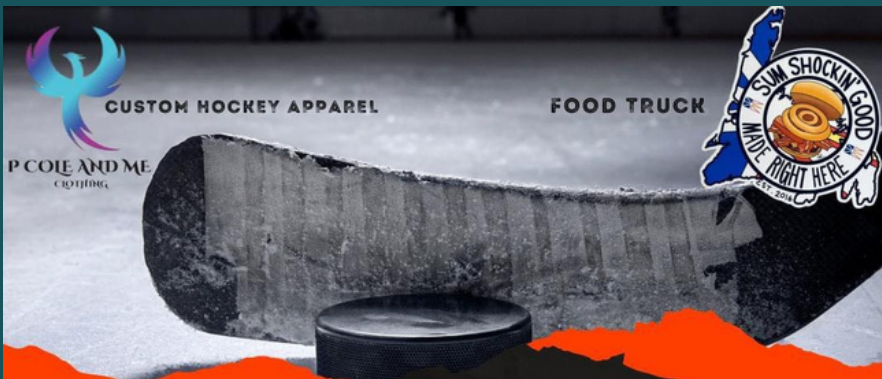

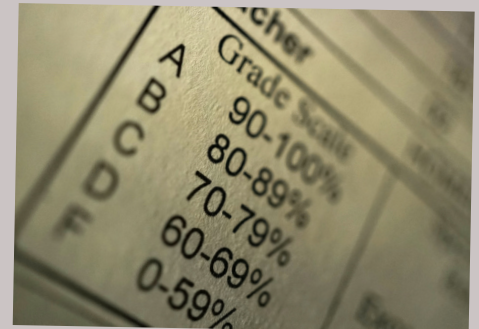
