We encourage all parents of high school students to sign up and meet with their child's teachers to discuss progress and learning in Semester 2 courses.

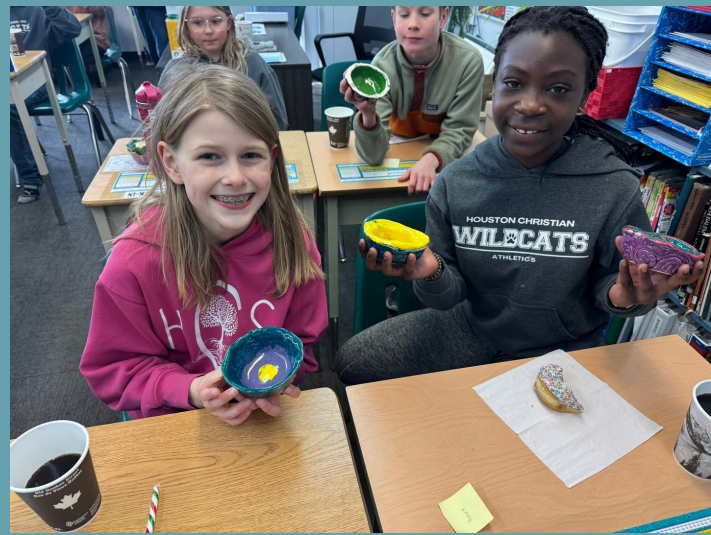
If you're unable to attend on Thursday but would still like to meet with a teacher, please feel free to contact them to arrange an alternative meeting time.



Grade 5/6 Pottery



The Grade 5/6 students recently completed a hands-on pottery project, crafting small clay bowls from start to finish. They began by learning basic hand-building techniques to shape their bowls from clay. After the bowls were shaped, they were placed in the kiln for a short firing, which hardened the clay and made them ready for glazing. Students then used a variety of ceramic glazes to add color and design to their bowls. Finally, the glazed bowls were fired a second time in the kiln at a high temperature, which melted the glaze into a smooth, glassy finish. The result was a beautiful handmade pottery piece that the students could keep for themselves or give to a special loved one.
