PRINCIPAL'S PULSE (WORDS FROM OUR HEAD)


This past week, I came across a booklet at the house where I am staying titled Stones for the Lord. It is a celebration of the first 25 years of Houston Christian School (1962–1987). It is a beautiful testimony of the dedication of those early parents who desired a Christian Education for their children. It took the work of the entire church community to make the dream a reality. It took years for them to see this dream come true. The first step was a meeting held on July 12, 1950, to begin organizing the Christian School. However, the school's doors would not open for another 12 years, finally welcoming students in September of 1962.
