This year, HCS will once again be offering our three traditional winter fundraisers:


CHRISTMAS GREENERY & POINSETTIA FUNDRAISER

Earlier this week, Rob let us know he had some unexpected availability next week, and we were thrilled to jump at the opportunity to welcome him to HCS.












OUTDOOR EDUCATION SHELTER BUILDING
