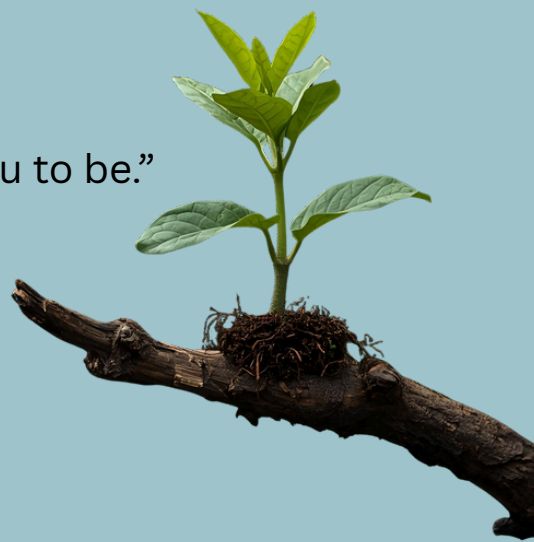
You are not who you used to be. And, by God's grace, you're becoming more of the person he has called you to be."

# School Board Update

## *Highlights and Information*

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Dear School Community,

We are excited to share an update regarding the Deep Roots Fundraiser and the platform lift project. As shared in the most recent Branches edition, we are incredibly thankful to have exceeded our original fundraising goal of \$20,000 through the *Lift Up* campaign. In addition to these funds, we were deeply blessed by a generous anonymous donation that completed the remaining funding needed for the project. With the total budgeted cost of the platform lift at \$120,000, we are thrilled to announce that the lift has now been officially ordered and is currently being manufactured.

With funding secured and plans moving forward smoothly, we anticipate beginning construction at the school in the next month. Our goal is to have everything prepared and ready for the lift installation during Spring Break. Following the installation, there will be some additional drywalling and finishing work required to fully complete the project. Some of the construction will take place during school hours. We want to reassure families that student safety is always our top priority, and all work areas will be carefully managed to ensure students remain safe throughout the process.

We have seen God's hand at work in how smoothly and quickly this project has come together, clearly reflecting His provision and faithfulness. We are grateful that this work will significantly improve accessibility at our school and better support all members of our community.

We look forward to sharing more updates as the project progresses.
