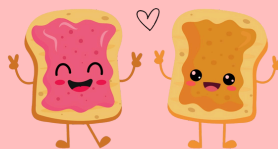
- Kindergarten parents are asked to plan to attend their child's student-led conference after school the following Thursday, as Mrs. Kobes will not be available during this session.
